## DIRECTIONS:

Highway 101 – Take the Route 92 exit west (towards Half Moon Bay)  
Take the Alameda de las Pulgas exit.  
At the end of the exit ramp, turn left and proceed about 1.5 blocks  
to the  
complex. light at 20<sup>th</sup>. Turn right at the light, into the 2000 Alameda

Interstate 280 – Take route 92 exit east (towards San Mateo and the bridge)  
Take the Alameda de las Pulgas exit.  
At the end of the exit ramp, turn left and proceed about 1.5 blocks  
to the  
complex. light at 20<sup>th</sup>. Turn right at the light, into the 2000 Alameda

El Camino Real - At 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue, turn west and proceed to Alameda de las Pulgas.  
Cross Alameda into the 2000 Alameda complex. (no turns)

## Parking at 2000 Alameda de las Pulgas:

You may park in the visitor lot outdoors and walk up the stairs to the main lobby, or park underneath the building and take the elevator to floor 1.

## Inside the Building

Environmental Health is located on floor 1.

As you step out of the elevator, turn left and left again.

Or from the front lobby doors, turn right and then left.

The EH conference room is located just beyond our visitor reception desk.
