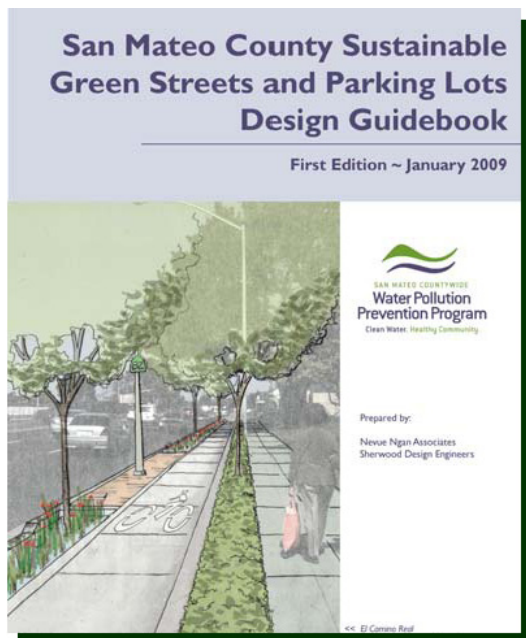

Workshop Highlights:

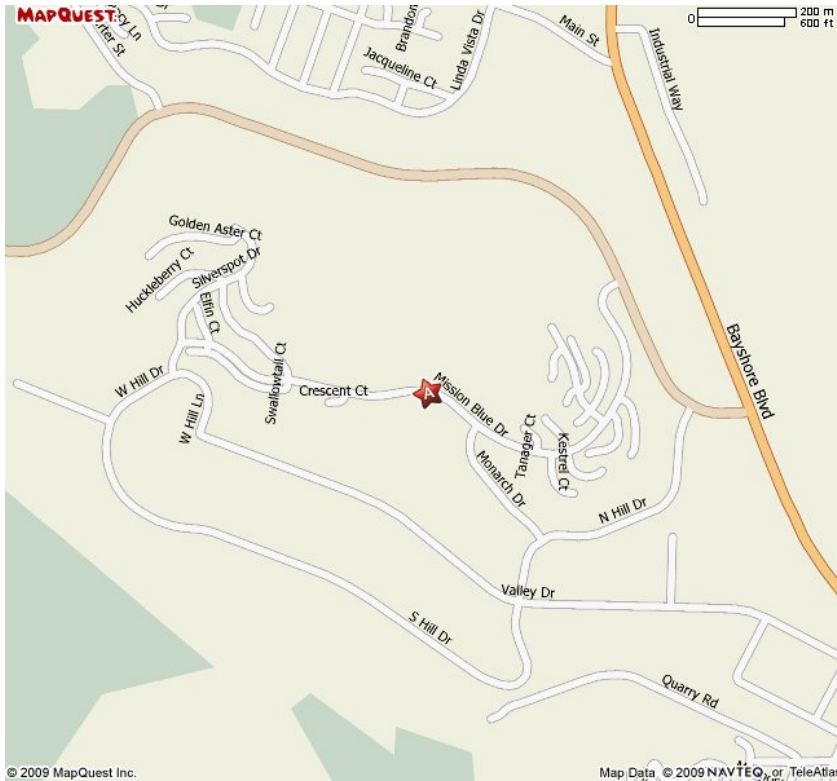
